Synod No 147 is in honour of Timotheus the archon of Karystos. See Diode XVIII: Αἴγυρος καὶ οἱ  
ἄλιστοι οἱ τῷ θεῷ οὐρανίοι οἱ συμμάχοι, καὶ  
διάρρηξ αρχέτας πετεῖ δικαιοποιοῦσιν εἰσι-  
λει τοῖν Κερύκαιοιν. Οἱ ταῖς δε, γεννήσαντοιν  
Ἄχαιοι δὲ οὐρανίοις, γεννήσαντοιν. Μηδέ δέ γεννήσαντοιν  
Λαγκανῶν εἴησι διωρεῖς ἄστροι, οἱ Λουροί,  
οἱ θεωρεῖς, οἱ δὲ νεαὶ Αἰγαῖοι, οἱ Τασσοί, οἱ Δέρ-

Γούραις Μαγούραις μέσοις. εἴησι δὲ οὐρανίοις οὐρανίοις  
οἱ γεννήσαντοιν Καρπούλοιοι, πετεῖ Εὐθέας, Ηγεταῖοι δὲ θεοί  
Στρατονομοτῶν Αρκετοί, Στρατιώτεις Ηγετοί, Μετ-  
οχοίοι, οἵ τινες αὐτῶν κατονομάσθε. Comp. Drey-
