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Dear Professor Andreades.

I regret to have put you to so much trouble, but I never imagined that after sending me recommendations to 48 Φαβιέρου you would send the last one to Cook's. I am very sorry that my indications were not clear and I am always grateful for your thoughtfulness. I have written εγνωνοτι to the Minister of the Interior to thank him for his kindness.

Some of my reasons for thinking that Chateaubriand never went to Sparta or Mistra are 1. That he arrived in Athens 2 days earlier than he states (Letters of Franbel to Choiseul-Lafayette published in R. Hist. Lit. de la France 1906) 2. That Chateaubriand

(1904.) etc. etc. My hypothesis  
is that Chateaubriand proceeded from  
Nodon to Coon to Tripolis, Jezzera,

I have not reached any definite  
conclusion, and I do not know whether  
I shall be able to reach any <sup>even</sup> after I  
thoroughly study the sources that Chateaubriand  
used for his description of that region.
