The capture of Selymbria was a brilliant exploit
 according to Plutarch. Alcibi. 20. cf. Diod.
 xiii 66. Xenophon (Hell. i. 3. 10) simply says:

Ἀλκιβιάδης δὲ τοῖς ἔργοις (the convention with Phar-
 nabazos) οὐκ ἐβόησαν ὡς οὐκ ἔμελλε Σελυμβρί-
 ας τῷ ἑαυτοῦ ἐπὶ τῇ Βουλῇ ἐκείνῃ.
 The present decree prescribes the conditions un-
 der which Selymbria is restored to the Ather-
 nian alliance. The earlier lines are much broken;
 and the heading is lost. After other provisions
 the document proceeds thus

111. § 1. Remission of debts owing to Athens [ὅσα δὲ ὀφεί-

o. 111. §. 3 Property of Athens or of the allies left at Telymbria, and lost or spent in the war, not to be required back again: [ὅσα δὲ ἀπὸ τῆς ἐν τῷ πόλει περιουσίας Ἀθηναίων ἢ τῶν συμμάχων, ἢ ἐκ τῆς ἀποσκευῆς ἢ καταβλήσεως ἐκπέσῃς τοῦ πολέμου οἱ ἄρχοντες μὴ εἶναι ἐπαίειν ὅτις τις καὶ οὐκ εἶσιν.]

§4 Private contracts not dissolved: [ὁ δὲ ἄλλο γινώσκων τὴν ἐκτέλει ἐν τοῖς ἰδιώταις ὡς ἰδιώταις ἢ ἰδιώτῃ, ὡς τὸ κοινὸν ἢ κοινῶς ὡς ἰδιώτῃ ἢ ἐὰν ἢ ἄλλο πρῶτον ἐκ ἀνύμεν ὡς ἀνθρώπος, ἢ δ' ἐκ ἀποστέλλων, τίνας εἶναι αὐτὸ συνέβαινεν.

§ 5 These provisions to be inscribed: oaths interchan-

§ 6. Decree of Alcibiades, confirming the above agreement, and adding certain provisions:

Compare No 28. Aristides arrived at Athens
 B.C. 408, on the day of the Mysteria twenty fifth
 of Thargelion (June) and stayed until the Eleu-
 sinia were over (Sept) within this time this de-
 cree was passed. I follow the chronology of Cur-
 tius Gr. Gesch ii 680
